

By giving women the tools to lead, educating them about their communities' needs and putting their unique brand of creativity and skill to work, JLSC is making a big impact on Florida's Space Coast with our three signature projects: Blast Off to Reading, Fueling Families, and Kids in the Kitchen.



Only 9% of girls 13 to17 are interested in careers in STEM, down from 11% in a similar survey in 2018 (Junior Achievement USA, 2019).

Blast Off to Reading focuses on introducing girls to STEM fields and encouraging them to grow more confident in their literacy skills.



Approximately 23,000 children and youth residing in Brevard County are at risk of or are currently experiencing food insecurity (17%).

Fueling Families stocks food pantries at schools across the county. These provisions help feed hungry kids during the school day, at after-school care, and at home.



United States Department of Agriculture officially declared Brevard County a food desert in 2020 (Rogers, 2020).

Kids in the Kitchen events hosted by Leagues around the country showcase how kids and their families can eat smart and make healthy lifestyle choices.
